Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee

The UAF Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee shall evaluate all aspects of this program during its biannual review of the UAF Animal Care program. This review includes evaluation of the forms and procedures associated with the implementation of this policy.

The Office of Research Integrity (ORI) is responsible for:

1. establishing and maintaining an OHSP for animal care workers and others who have substantial animal contact;
2. the resources necessary to implement this policy; consultation with the animal care provider and the animal facility committee lead or designee;
3. provide information and training to university members regarding health and safety issues associated with the work with animals;
4. administer the OHSP, including authorization of occupational health services by the university's contract animal care provider; and
5. monitor the standards of hygiene and safety of university members.
